In basic training, our staff will give you a better grasp on the FFEL Program, borrower eligibility requirements, loan certification, packaging, and disbursement and delivery.

On September 19, our schedule begins with an away game. Our first advanced training will be at UA Community College at Batesville (UACCB) at West Banquet Hall in Independence Hall. September 26, the SLGFA team will hit the road again with advanced training at UA Fort Smith at the Latture Conference Center in the Business and Professional Institute.

Then on October 9 and 10, we will host two home games, a basic training session and an advanced training session, respectively, in our David Pryor Training Room.

Participation will be limited to 50 people at UACCB and UA Fort Smith and to 40 people at the David Pryor Training Room. Registration will start at 8:30 a.m. Workshops will last from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

To keep your players healthy for the game, we're also offering morning and afternoon refreshments and a light lunch.
